MediPendant™

MediPendant™ is the world's first fully-monitored two-way voice speakerphone pendant for the PERS (*personal emergency response system*) industry. Medical Alarm Concepts™ has taken the proven PERS concept and enhanced it with new state-of-the-art technology. The MediPendant™ has some similarity to that of other PERS units on the market today in that all systems utilize a small pendant worn by the user. But, while all the other systems require the user to be close to the base of the unit in order to have a conversation with the attendant on the other end of the line, MediPendant™ has no such requirement. With the MediPendant™, the user can speak and listen directly through the pendant, and have a two-way conversation with an operator from virtually anywhere in and around their home. With over 600+ feet (line of sight) of range, the MediPendant™ enables the user to wander inside and outside their home with limited restrictions. No other PERS unit on the market today has this capability. It is a huge advancement for the PERS industry.

LifeSafety Monitoring

MediPendant™ was designed to be used as a call center monitoring device. The MediPendant™ is programmed to dial a pre-designated proprietary call center. The call center provides multilingual monitoring services for the user 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The operator can dispatch the needed authorities, such as police, fire, and medical personnel, as well as family, friends or designated contacts. LifeSafety Monitoring™ takes this one step further, by staffing the call center with licensed EMT (Emergency Medical Technician) operators. The call center provides monitoring services for the user 365 days a year. The call center can also maintain an updated list of medications and health information for all MediPendant™ users. This information is given to the dispatched authority if necessary.
